

WHOSE BED?

Count: 32. Wall: 4. Level: Beginner

Choreographer: Joshua Talbot (AUS) - July 2025

Music: **Whose Bed Have Your Boots Been Under?** by Shania Twain. Album: The Woman In Me

INTRO: 44 count from second time she sings "Whose Bed have your boots been under" when the beat kicks in.

Dance will officially start about 26 seconds into the track on the word "Lonely". Four Tags

CROSS, ROCK, SIDE, ROCK, CROSS, ROCK, CHASSE RIGHT

1,2 Cross Rock R over L, Recover onto L

3,4 Rock R to right, Recover onto L

5,6 Cross Rock R over L, Recover onto L

7&8 Step R to right, Step L beside R, Step R to right

CROSS, ROCK, SIDE, ROCK, CROSS, ROCK, CHASSE LEFT

1,2 Cross Rock L over R, Recover onto R

3,4 Rock L to left, Recover onto R

5,6 Cross Rock L over R, Recover onto R

7&8 Step L to left, Step R beside L, Step L to left

JAZZ BOX 1/4 RIGHT, TOGETHER, JAZZ BOX 1/4 RIGHT, TOGETHER

1-4 Cross R over L, Turn $\frac{1}{8}$ right step L back, Turn $\frac{1}{8}$ right step R to right, Step L beside R **[3:00]**

5-8 Cross R over L, Turn $\frac{1}{8}$ right step L back, Turn $\frac{1}{8}$ right step R to right, Step L beside R **[6:00]**

VINE RIGHT, TOUCH, 3/4 REVERSE TURN, SCUFF

1-4 Step R to right, Step L behind R, Step R to right, Touch L beside R

5-8 Turn $\frac{1}{4}$ right step L back, Turn $\frac{1}{2}$ right step R forward, Step L forward, Scuff R

NOTE: This is NOT a rolling vine over the Left. It is a $\frac{3}{4}$ turn Right while travelling Left.

Non turning option: VINE LEFT 1/4, SCUFF

5-8 Step L to left, Step R behind L, Turn $\frac{1}{4}$ left step L forward, Scuff R

32 REPEAT

TAGS: End of Walls 2, 4, 6 & 11

Tags will happen at 6:00, 12:00, 6:00 & 9:00

1-4 Step R forward, Touch L beside R, Step L back, Touch R beside L

(When stepping L back, open body to left diagonal, ready to start your cross rock)

Note: There could have been a lot more tags/restarts added. However, I decided to keep to the 4 count tags.

The phrasing will go out from time to time but the beat is still good.

The tags will bring it all back into place. This is also the reason for the late start.
